

Order Split

Description

This allows performing voluntary split on multi-passenger orders that are issued or not issued.

Limitation

- It is not possible to reassociate an infant with another adult during the split.
- It is not possible to split the itinerary.

Process

- OrderChangeRQ on a multi-pax order with the "DIV" indicator to trigger a split. The query must contain the references of the passengers for the child order.
- OrderViewRS with Child order and Parent order's reference.
